## Northeast Baseball League, Inc. Amendment to Constitution 4-3-2008

## Use of an Extra Hitter, (EH) in your Batting Lineup

A 10th player may now be used in your batting lineup subject to the following conditions.

- If you want to use an EH in your lineup, you must start the game with that EH. Which means that before the first pitch is thrown the opposing team must have your lineup with 10 batters. You cannot insert a 10th batter once the game has started.
- 2. You may substitute your EH, which is subject to the Leagues re-entry rule.
- 3. If you start the game with an EH and only have 10 players, or you have substituted all your subs. then a player is injured or ejected from the game, and you have no substitute to re-enter for that missing player, you can continue with a 9 player batting lineup with no penalty or out assigned to the missing players batting position.
- 4. You may change your EH to playing a position on the field, but not the position that player is batting in your lineup. You can not swap the same player in your batting order once your lineup is established. Again, subject to the Leagues re-entry rule.
- You may also use an EH with a DH. (Designated Hitter) Subject to the Leagues DH rule on page 4.
